President's Report

The President talked about her attendance at the poorly organized GWC opening meeting. About 30 attended.

She reminded the vice-presidents and the negotiations officer about the October 4 negotiations workshop presented by the District beginning at 8:30 a.m.

At the present 44 people have made reservations for the picnic. G'Bye suggested laying a "guilt trip" on those who didn't attend. Following a the picnic a survey will be sent to all asking about activities that they will support.

Vice-Presidents' Reports

Tom Chambers (Coastline) – The CCC opening of school meeting was well-organized and well-attended. He met a number of PT faculty and answered questions.

John Dunham (Golden West) – Went to first Academic Senate meeting. Found it civil and interesting. Questions from PT faculty have been on unemployment and travel funds.

Rick Boone (Orange Coast) – Focus Day went well although there were only a handful of part-time faculty. He has been emphasizing getting PT faculty onto college committees to gain them attention. He has reviewed the USB thumb drives and will send possible colors to the President who will distribute them to the Board for interest. Staff development may be available for PT faculty at OCC. He will get more info. Mentorship programs for part-timers have been discussed in committee and are the subject of a survey. The mentor could be full-time or part-time. Ideas should be sent to Rick. The Academic Senate is discussing part-time offices. The general consensus of the Board was a central office for all PT'ers. Finally, he has been elected to the CCA Part-time Issues Committee. They are meeting September 25.
